## Roaring Fork Nature Trail Loop

Roaring Fork is a five-mile one-way tour that is referred to as a "motor nature trail" because most of the sights are easily seen from an automobile or are a short walk from the road. Along the route you can visit the historic Bud Ogle Farm home, a water mill, and other buildings to see what life in the mountains of Tennessee were like in the late 1800's. If you are feeling energetic you can also take a short 1.2 mile hike along a beautiful mountain stream to Grotto Falls. (Look for the sign. Don't leave valuables in your car!)

Just a way down the road, Roaring Fork Creek parallels the road for some distance and except during times of low water you will enjoy many sights with the most beautiful being a waterfall named "Place of a Thousand Drips".

Important: No large trucks, RVs or trailers are allowed because the road is very narrow. In fact, in some places, trees encroach right to the edge of the road. This area is often closed in winter when snow or ice is present.

#	DIRECTIONS	DISTANCE
1.	Jackson Mtn. Homes, Left on US-321 to US-441	3.4 mi
2.	Keep left on US-441	.6 mi
3.	Turn left at Light #8 on Historic Motor Nature Trail Road	.7 mi
4.	Keep right at entrance to Park Vista Hotel into the park
